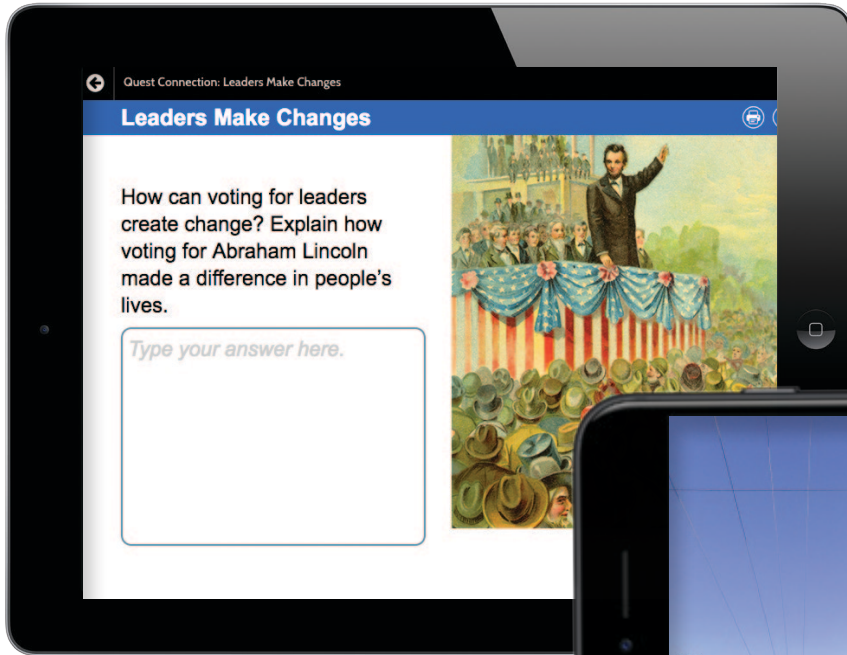

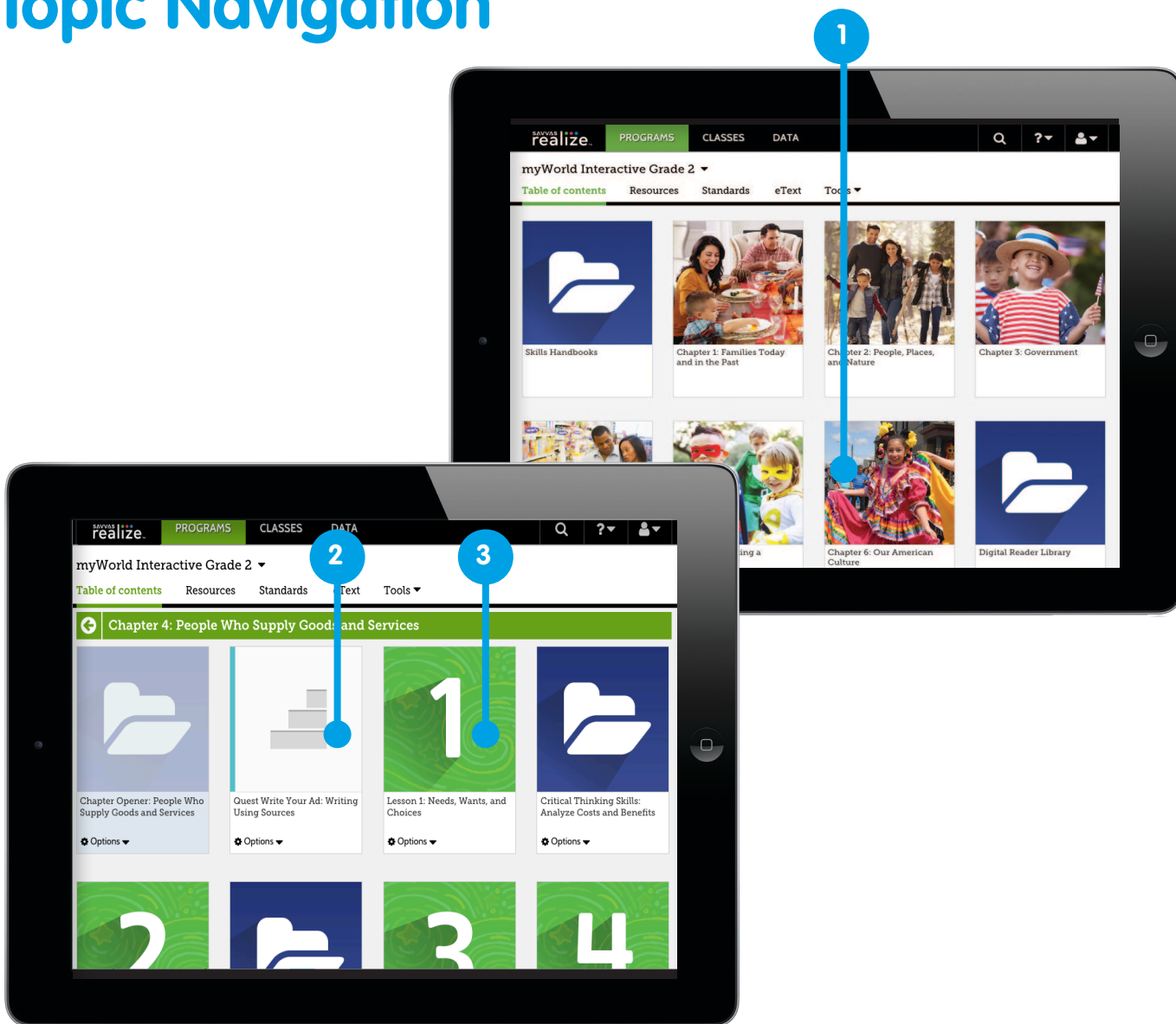


- Click on **eTEXT** at the top of the digital page to access your digital textbook.

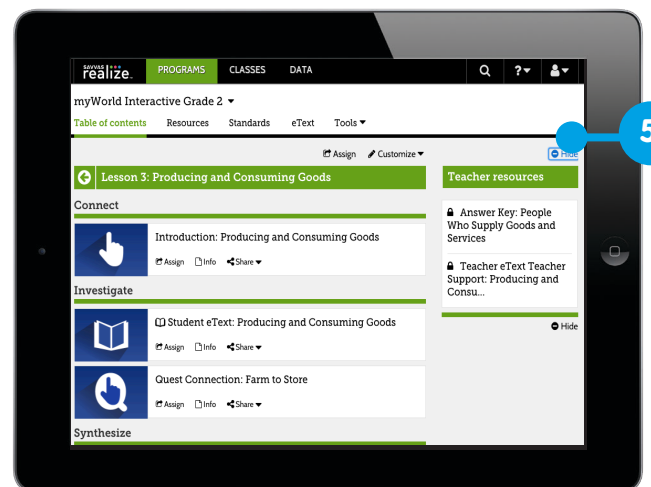
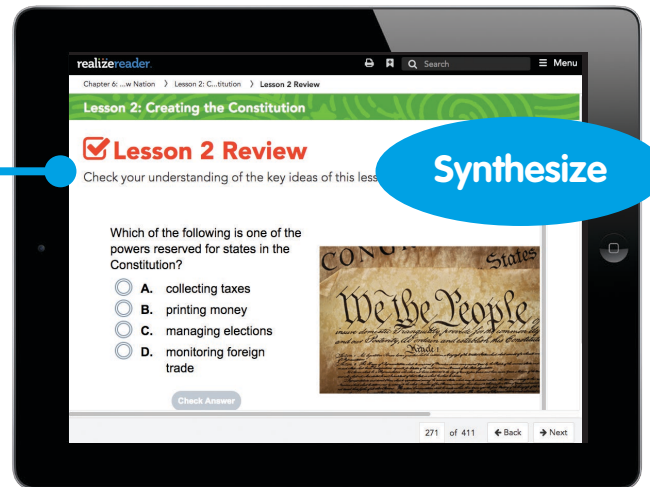
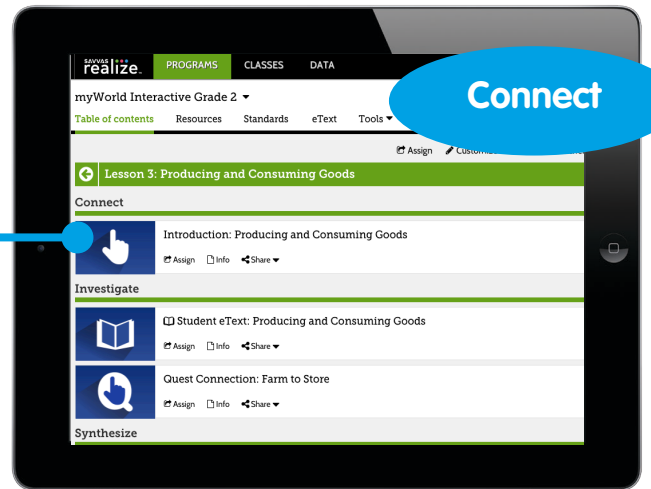


- 1 From the **TABLE OF CONTENTS**, select a **Chapter** to pull up all of your content and resources.

- 3 Select a **LESSON** to view more content and resources.

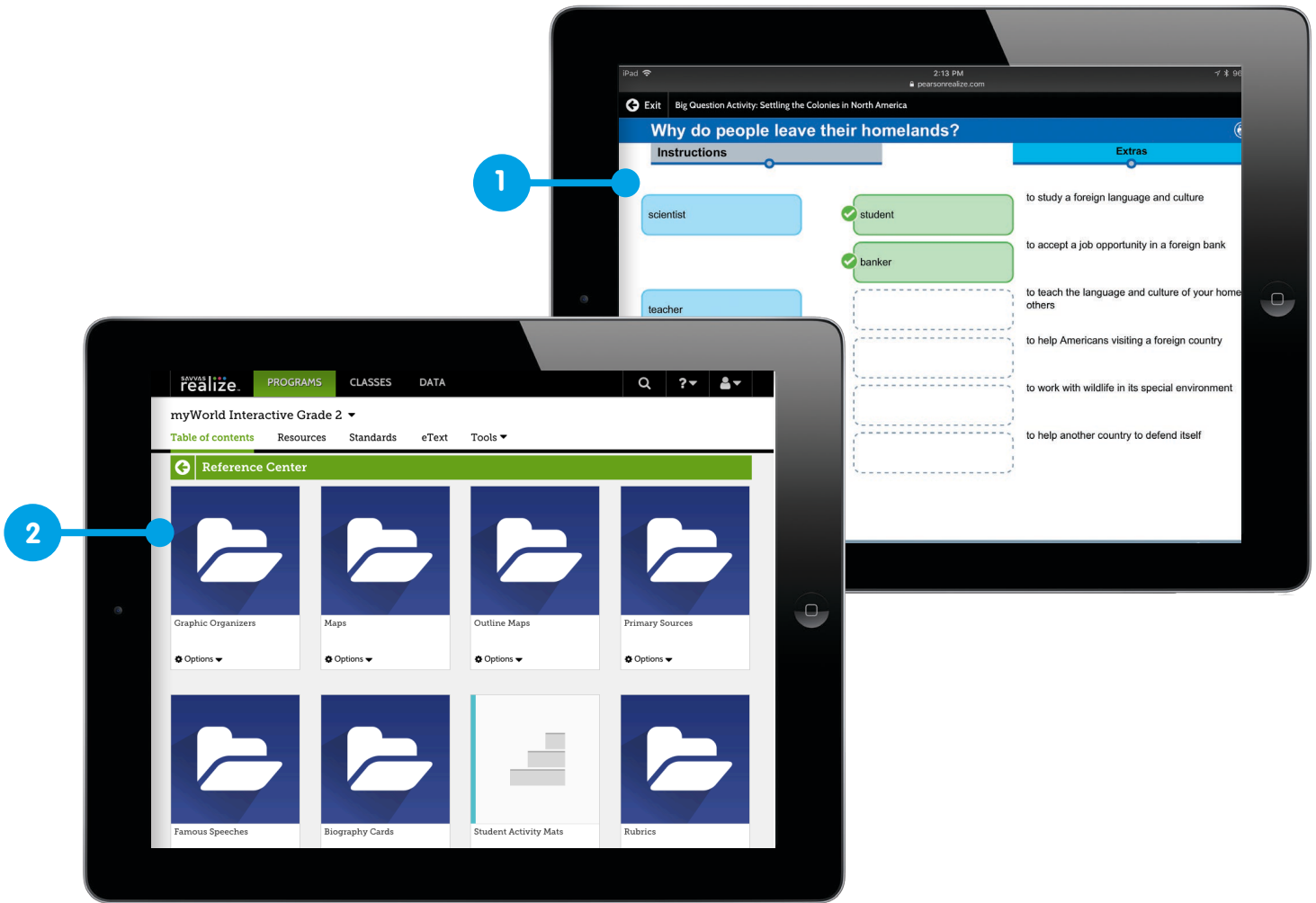
4 Each lesson is organized around the four-part inquiry learning model: **Connect, Investigate, Synthesize, Demonstrate**

- **CONNECT** contains a start-up activity to introduce content to students.
- In **INVESTIGATE**, students can use the embedded **Notebook** as they explore content, videos, galleries, and other digital interactives.
- Students will **SYNTHESIZE** information through an online Lesson Review that brings together content from the lesson and asks them to apply the concepts they have learned.
- The lesson ends with **DEMONSTRATE** where students will take an assessment so you can check their understanding of content.

5 Select **Teacher resources** to view answer keys, lesson summaries, and other teacher support tools.

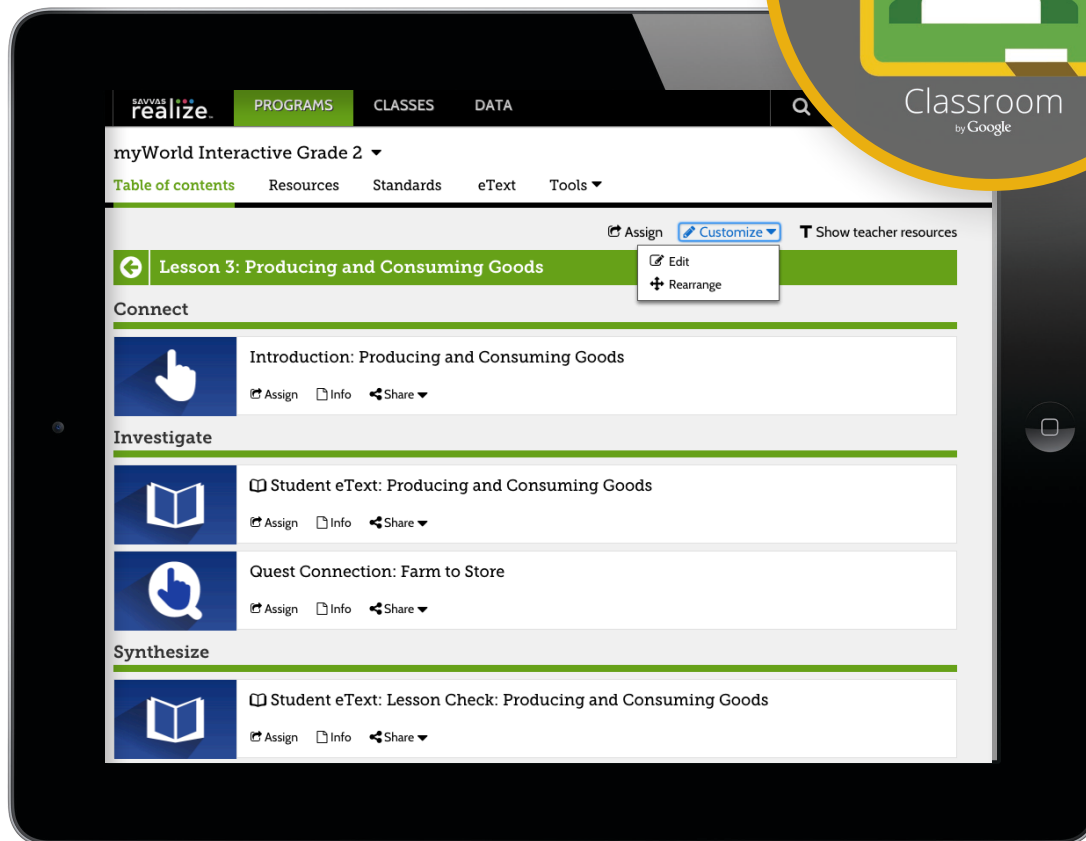

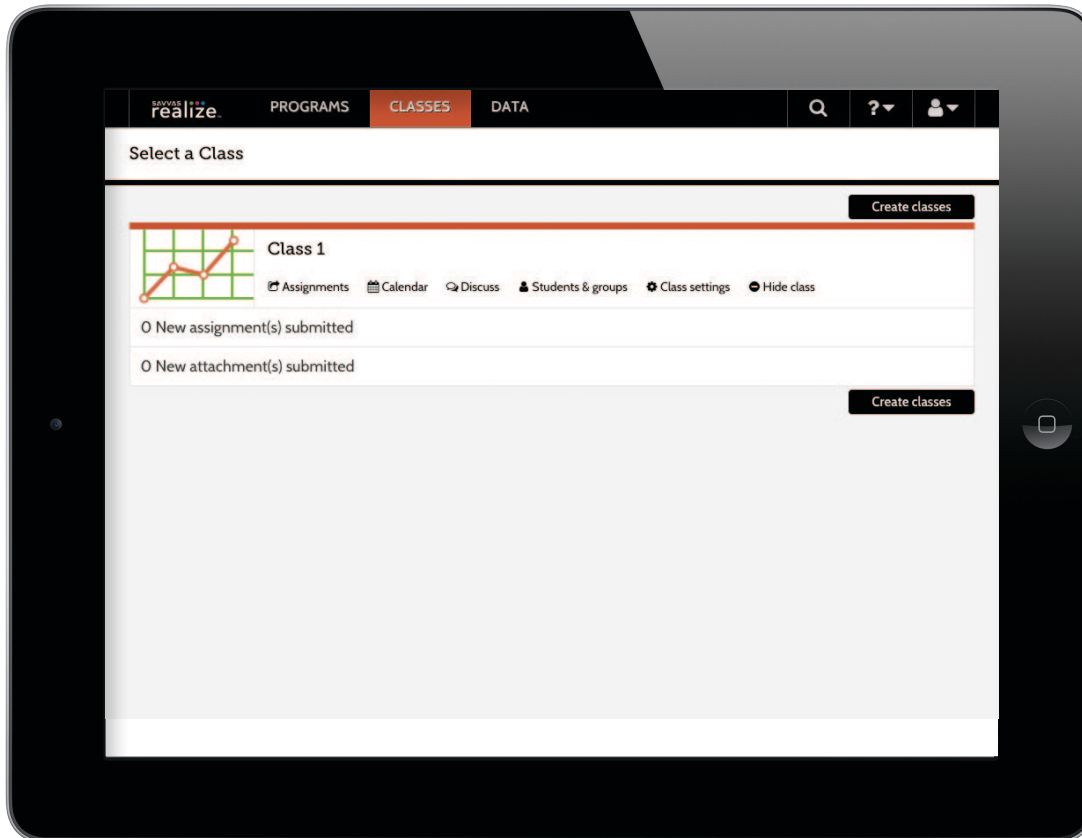

**2** Select **CALENDAR** to view all class assignments by week or by month. You can auto schedule lesson plans for the entire year and block days out in advance.

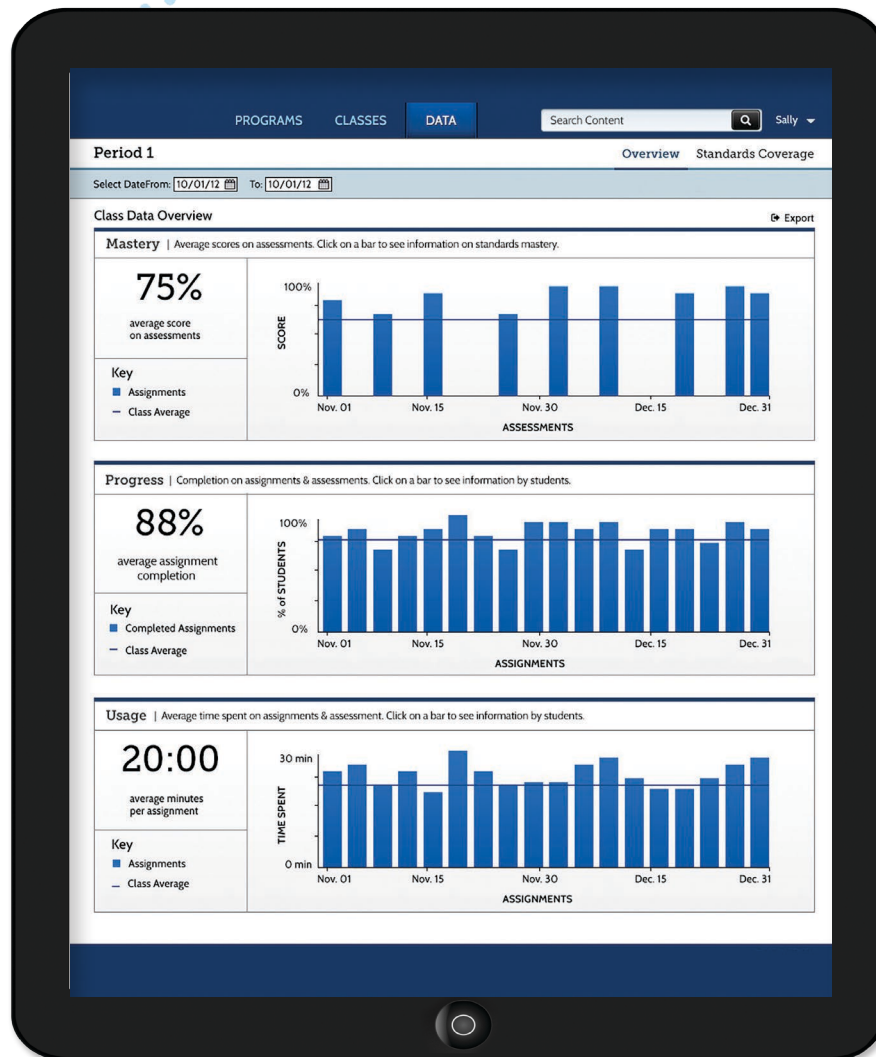
**3** Select **DISCUSS** to begin a discussion topic.
