

The Governor's University Research Initiative (GURI) provides grants to bring bright researchers to the state to study science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and medicine. In addition to the Texas Medical Center (TMC), the world's largest medical center, Texas is home to 15 medical universities. Texans are working to discover new cures and treatments for cancer at the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas (CPRIT). Not just focusing on cancer, Texas has over 2,000 biotechnology-related research and development companies and is a leader in developing treatments against infectious disease.
