The following funding sources are available to school districts to implement Savvas CTE:

| Funding Source | Distribution to Districts | How Funds Support Career Pathways |
|---|---------------------------------|---|
| Perkins V | Formula | "Distance and/or blended learning CTE programs" is one of the allowable uses of Perkins V funds |
| Title I, Part A | Formula | Can fund academic, career, and technical education content through coordinated instructional strategies, which may incorporate experiential learning opportunities and promote skills attainment important to in-demand occupations or industries in the state |
| Title II, Part A | Formula | Professional development for teachers and principals |
| Title IV, Part A - Student Support and Academic Enrichment | Formula, based on Title I | Can fund career awareness and exploration activities |
| Perkins Reserve fund | Varies by state | States can reserve up to 15% of Perkins funds to spur CTE innovation among local eligible recipients of Perkins funds |
| State-specific grants | Varies by state | Many states fund grants related to CTE, college/career readiness, STEM, industry credentials, and workforce development |
