Funding Source	Distribution to Districts	How Funds Support Career Pathways
Perkins V	Formula	"Distance and/or blended learning CTE programs" is one of the allowable uses of Perkins V funds
Title I, Part A	Formula	Can fund academic, career, and technical education content through coordinated instructional strategies, which may incorporate experiential learning opportunities and promote skills attainment important to in-demand occupations or industries in the state
Title II, Part A	Formula	Professional development for teachers and principals
Title IV, Part A - Student Support and Academic Enrichment	Formula, based on Title I	Can fund career awareness and exploration activities
Perkins Reserve fund	Varies by state	States can reserve up to 15% of Perkins funds to spur CTE innovation among local eligible recipients of Perkins funds
State-specific grants	Varies by state	Many states fund grants related to CTE, college/career readiness, STEM, industry credentials, and workforce development
